04 SEP: ARRIVE NAIROBI

Welcome to Kenya and the start of your Game Parks of Africa journey! On arrival at Nairobi Airport, you will be welcomed with a private Meet & Greet and transferred to your hotel in the capital. Enjoy the remainder of the day relaxing and preparing for the excitement ahead. *Tamarind Tree Hotel*

05 SEP: DISCOVER NAIROBI

Today, meet your fellow travellers for a full-day guided tour of Nairobi, where you will experience many of the city's philanthropic and conservation highlights, mixed in with history and culture.

Enjoy visits to the Elephant Orphanage at Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, the informative and interactive Giraffe Centre, the Karen Blixen farmhouse from "Out of Africa" fame — now a museum as well as the Kazuri Beads Factory, which employs over 300 women. Lunch is included at the Karen Blixen Coffee Gardens. Evening at leisure. *Tamarind Tree Hotel (BL)*

06 SEP: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Head south to Amboseli National Park, famous for having one of the best views of Mt. Kilimanjaro, located over the border in Tanzania. Enroute to the lodge, enjoy a game viewing activity to start your safari experience. *Amboseli Serena Lodge (BLD)*

07 SEP: ON SAFARI IN AMBOSELI

Enjoy a safari in Amboseli, famous for it's large herds of elephants and often referred to as "The Land of Giants". During morning and afternoon game viewing activities, the trained eyes and ears of the guide will help spot the varied flora and fauna of this popular park. *Amboseli Serena Lodge (BLD)*

08 SEP: LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

Depart Amboseli and stop for visa formalities at the border from Kenya into Tanzania. Once border formalities are complete, continue for lunch in the city of Arusha, Tanzania's safari gateway.

Your next stop is at Lake Manyara National Park, located in The Great Rift Valley region of northern Tanzania. This fracture in the earth's crust stretches approximately 7,000 kms from The Middle East to Southern Africa. Your lodge offers views from atop the 900m Mto wa Mbu escarpment, with the main panoramic feature being the Park's namesake: Lake Manyara. Lake Manyara Serena Lodge (BLD)

09 SEP: GAME VIEWING AT LAKE MANYARA

Enjoy morning and afternoon game viewing activities at Lake Manyara National Park. Enjoy the diverse scenery and chance to spot the park's tree-climbing lions! Enjoy viewing many other wildlife species including herds of elephants, various primates, antelope, giraffe and many more. *Lake Manyara Serena Lodge (BLD)*

10 SEP: NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

From Lake Manyara, continue north to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The Ngorongoro Crater is classed as a mixed World Heritage Site, as it is both a natural and cultural site of Tanzania. With its unbroken volcanic wall spanning nearly 20 km wide and over 600m high in some areas, the sunken Crater is a permanent home for a large concentration of wildlife.

Ngorongoro is the Maasai word for "Big Hole" and also relates to the sound that the Maasai cowbell makes as it swings from side to side. This region has been given many titles, from "Africa's Eden" to the unofficial "8th Natural Wonder of the World". Arrive at your lodge in time for lunch and enjoy the expansive views from the Crater rim. *Acacia Farm Lodge (BLD)*

11 SEP: NGORONGORO CRATER

Leave early and descend into the depths of the Crater for a safari, where you will explore the different habitats and ecosystems of the crater. Keep a lookout for monkeys and elephants that frequent the small woodland forest areas, flamingos wading in the salty basins of Lake Magadi and so much more. Stop at a scenic spot for a picnic lunch then return to the lodge. *Acacia Farm Lodge (BLD)*

12/13/14 SEP: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Today you will journey between the wildlife havens of Ngorongoro and Serengeti, another World Heritage Site of Tanzania. These rich and diverse ecosystems are synonymous with African wildlife and stunning scenery. Arrive at the lodge for lunch and afternoon at leisure. During your stay, enjoy game drives and game viewing activities, making the most to spot animals and birdlife.

We go in search of the famous migration of millions of herbivorous animals, known as "The Great Migration", which is a continuous cycle that occurs throughout the year. The location of these animals depends on local weather and feeding conditions. By following the rains, the animals can take advantage of the abundance of fresh grass in preparation for birthing their young. This is one of the finest examples of the "Circle of Life". Witnessing this natural phenomenon ultimately comes down to being in the right place at the right time. Even still, you will always witness large numbers of wildlife. Lahia Tented Lodge - 3 nights (BLD)

15/16/17/18 SEP: MASAI MARA

This morning, head to the Isebania Border, where you bid farewell to Tanzania and cross back into Kenya. Wildlife enthusiasts wanting to travel the path of the Great Migration are in for a treat! Even though the 'Mara' only welcomes migrating animals from the Serengeti for around three months of the year, the area is part of a safari circuit of one of nature's grandest spectacles.

You will experience the best seat in the house in one of the only lodges in the famed Mara Triangle - your remote corner of the Masai Mara National Reserve. Arrive in the early afternoon, with time to relax and enjoy the sweeping views of the surrounding savannah and the meandering Mara River. During your stay enjoy daily game drives and game activities. *Mara Serena Lodge - 4 nights (BLD)*

19 SEP: NAIROBI

After breakfast, enjoy your final safari experience before transferring to the hustle and bustle of Nairobi airport for the end of the tour.
